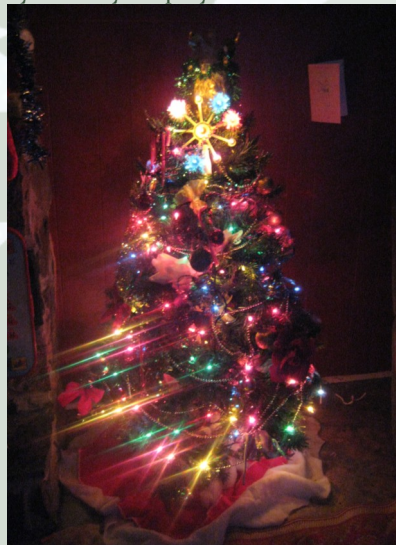
Partnerships...
